
PRIVILEGED USER INSIDER THREAT SURVEY RESULTS

Did you know that privileged users often are your riskiest employees?

Security from the inside-out is the key to achieving deep visibility and stopping insider threats.

INSIDER THREATS

VISIBILITY



62% are somewhat to not confident at all they have enterprise wide visibility for user access


55% do not or are unsure if they correlate data from multiple sources, 60% say this is due to lack of resources




58% are not confident because they do not have enterprise visibility

18% are very confident they have this visibility

ACCESS PRIVILEGES




SOCIAL ENGINEERING



46% surveyed said malicious insiders would use social engineering to obtain someone's access rights

48% believe social engineers from outside will target privileged users to obtain access rights

HUMAN FACTOR



74% think privileged users believe they are empowered to access all the information they can view




66% say these same people access sensitive or confidential data out of curiosity



58% point out organizations assign access to individuals that go beyond their role or responsibility

MANUAL PROCESS

BACKGROUND CHECKS



background checks lacking within organizations before issuance of privileged credentials

BUDGET

use manual processes to certify privileged users



59% have a dedicated budget, but 70% say the budget is 10% or less



80% of threats are internal



48% use SIEM to determine if action is an insider threat
