

Managing the GDPR's 72-Hour Reporting Mandate

Organizations that collect or process EU citizen records are required to notify the supervisory authority within 72 hours of becoming aware of a data breach.

Data Controllers Are Required to Provide Details of the Breach

Type of Breach



Confidentiality
A disclosure of personal data



Availability
A loss of access to or destruction of personal data



Integrity
Altercation of personal data

Nature of the Breach



The date and time of the breach



What was accessed and whom was impacted?



How is it being used?



Involved parties and their roles within the organization

Severity of the Breach



Describe potential consequences of the breach



What will be done to reduce the potential impacts of this breach?

Failure to comply may result in fines of up to 4% of worldwide turnover or €20 million (whichever is greater) for intentional or negligent violations.
Are you prepared to report this information within the 72-hour timeframe?
